

Edmonton Art Club Scholarship Information



EAC Policies

The Edmonton Art Club offers two scholarships to our members annually via an application process: The Card / Alling Scholarship and the Mildred Nelson Scholarship.

Card/Alling Scholarship is for studies in watercolour. Generally, two scholarships of \$2000.00 each are given annually.

Mildred Nelson Scholarship is for studies in mediums other than watercolour. Generally, one scholarship of \$1000.00 is given annually.

No member can receive both scholarships simultaneously. The receipt of a scholarship precludes the award of the same scholarship for ten years (during this 10-year period, the awarding of the other scholarship is permitted.)

Eligibility criteria is outlined in the application form. Should your qualifications meet the scholarship criteria, we encourage you to submit your application to the Scholarship Committee.

The Scholarship Committee:

- a. shall be comprised of at least 2 active members both of whom are past scholarship recipients. One member of this committee is replaced each year.
- b. Term of office for this committee shall be two years with an overlap of junior and senior members.
- c. The scholarship committee shall be appointed with the approval of the EAC membership.

Application deadline is April 30 of each year. Members can make application every ten years per scholarship.

The Scholarship Committee shall:

- a. ensure scholarship applications are made available at the appropriate time to the membership. Applications are available on the web site.
- b. acquire an independent juror for reviewing applications for a two-year term. An honorarium is paid to the external juror each year.
- c. ensure certificates are presented to successful candidates.
- d. be responsible for the June program and the awarding of scholarships. The previous year's award winners will each present a brief report on how the funds were used.
